1. Attend one of the College Connection Information Nights

2. Apply to Butte College - now to January 22

- Go to <u>www.butte.edu</u> click on the "APPLY NOW" button on the home page, create an account, complete and submit application (Applications may take 3 to 5 business days to process)
- Your enrollment status will be "enrolling in high school and college at the same time"
- Please enter your high school status accurately, "Haven't completed 11th grade"
- For assistance with the application, contact the Butte College Call Center @ 895-2511, and identify yourself as a College Connection applicant; or meet with your high school counselor
- o If you are already a Butte College student and/or you have received Butte credits for a class you've taken at PHS, **you still need to reapply** https://home.cccapply.org/
- Save or screenshot the email with your Butte College: ID, password, and Butte student email address.

3. Ask three teachers to recommend you

- Detach the three recommendation forms from the back of the application (pgs. 6, 7, & 8)
- Use the most current teachers possible for the subjects required (math, English, and science or foreign language)
- Fill in the blanks on the top of each of the three forms
- Meet with your teachers outside of class time to share your interest in CC and ask for their recommendation using the required form
- You will NOT be collecting these forms after your teachers complete them (see instructions on form)
